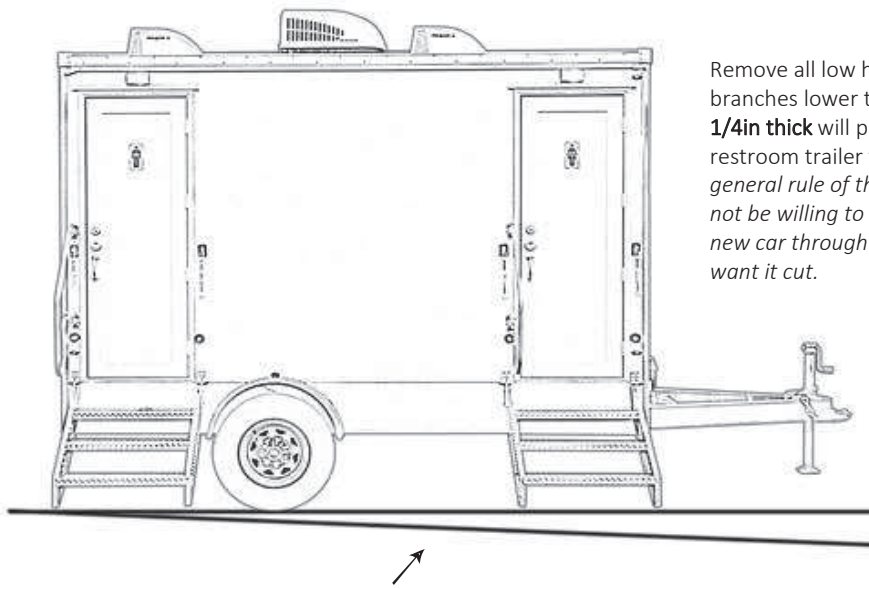
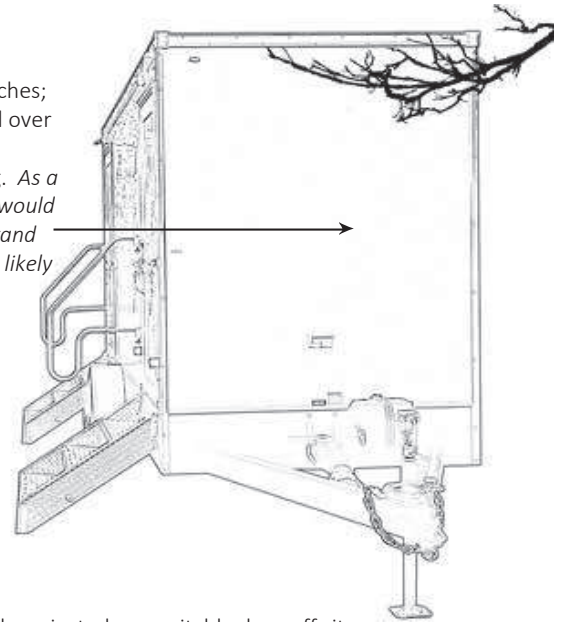


Extremely Important: Restroom Delivery, Usage & Warnings

This page will help you prepare your site for our restroom delivery, and help keep your restrooms functional for the duration of your event.



Remove all low hanging branches; branches lower than **12ft** and over **1/4in thick** will prevent our restroom trailer from passing. As a general rule of thumb, if you would not be willing to drive your brand new car through it, we would likely want it cut.



Inclines over **8 degrees** longitudinal (front to back) are dangerous for your guests and property and will be rejected as a suitable drop off site. Inclines over **4 degrees** transverse (left to right) may exceed the stair adjustments or prevent us from leveling the trailer properly.

30 Minutes of Standby Time

Included in your restroom trailer rental is 30 minutes of "standby" while we're at your site. This is time in which the driver is on site waiting/prepping the site instead of dropping off/setting up the restroom (popular reasons for this include improper site prep or not having thought out the placement of the restroom beforehand). After the 30 minutes has concluded we will assess a \$1 per minute charge in addition to the rental.

Picking the Perfect Site

- If possible have one backup location for the restroom trailer in case something is wrong with the first location.
- Remember that the stairs add 2ft to the width of the trailer, we also recommend having 2ft width for your pathway (if needed).
- Our trailers have the restroom stall entrances on the passenger side (right side when looking at it from the rear).
- Please allow enough space for the tow vehicle (a full size pickup) to drop off, detach the trailer and exit the property, it's very unlikely that the trailer can be moved after the removal of the tow vehicle due to the weight of the trailer, the enormous manpower needed and risk to safety.

Getting to Your Site

- We require a minimum width of 8ft of drivable unobstructed roadway and 10ft-12ft around corners depending on sharpness
- The roadway must be 2wd accessible (certain situations with steep gravel driveways may be impassible due to the extra weight of the trailer).
- Severe changes of incline may prevent us from proceeding due to the risk of bottoming out the trailer.
- Our tow vehicles/trailers have a 3 lane turn radius and may not be able to make the same U-turn as your vehicle.
- Once we dropped our trailer off it cannot be moved without the written consent of Fancy Flush (please call or email us before attempting to move our restroom trailers).

Extra Cleaning Fees

Though rare, Fancy Flush may assess extra charges for cleaning unnecessarily soiled restrooms. This fee will apply to clean vomit, "potty training" accidents, tar, glue, scratch and vandalism removal etc. Fees will be assessed based on the difficulty and time it takes to restore the restroom to rental state.



Conserve Consumables

Please be aware that the consumable items of the restroom such as water, battery power, toilet paper, hand towels and hand soap are not guaranteed to last the duration of your event. As a courtesy we may provide some extra consumables like toilet paper and hand towels, these items are typically located in the service room or under the sink. Though most of our fleet of trailers includes solar panels to generate electricity, this system performance varies greatly due to the time of day, the weather and the amount of sunlight the location receives.



Fire Risk

Due to fire risk, items with open flames, such as candles, lanterns, cigarettes, are not allowed in or around the trailer.
